```
# RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-f
# RewriteCond %{REQUEST_URI} ^/[^(^/)+)/(, +)$
# RewriteCond %{DOCUMENT_ROOT}/%1/data/cache/html/%2 -f
# RewriteRule ^(.*)$ /%1/data/cache/html/%2 [L,R]
RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-f
RewriteCond %{DOCUMENT_ROOT}/data/cache/html/%{REQUEST_URI} -f
RewriteRule ^(.+)$ data/cache/html/$1
```

*# The following rule tells Apache that if the requested filename  
# exists, simply serve it.*

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} -s [OR]
RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} -l [OR]
RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} -d
RewriteRule ^.*$ - [NC,L]
```

*# The following rewrites all other queries to index.php. The  
# condition ensures that if you are using Apache aliases to do  
# mass virtual hosting, the base path will be prepended to  
# allow proper resolution of the index.php file; it will work  
# in non-aliased environments as well, providing a safe, one-size  
# fits all solution.*

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_URI}::$1 ^(/, +)(, +)::\2$
RewriteRule ^(.*) - [E=BASE:%1]
RewriteRule ^(.*)$ %{ENV:BASE}index.php [NC,L]
```
