RewriteEngine On

Change '/sitecmd/' to the directory containing sitecmd's index.php file.
Use '/' if sitecmd is located within your public_html (or similar) directory.
RewriteBase /

Uncomment the following lines if you would like to redirect all
URLs from http://example.com to http://www.example.com.
Replace 'example.com' with the domain you are using with sitecmd.
You can also swap these around if you want to do it the other way.
#RewriteCond %{HTTP_HOST} ^example.com [NC]
#RewriteRule .* http://www.example.com/\$0 [R=301,L]

Sitecmd routing rules.

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-f
RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-d
RewriteRule .* index.php/\$0 [PT]
